PENNSYLVANIA NATIVE BRINGS COMEDY SUCCESS HOME!

PERFORMER ANDY PRESCOTT BRINGS ORIGINAL ONE-MAN SHOW TO REGION'S AUDIENCES AFTER NEW YORK SUCCESS --

"ANDY PRESCOTT 'AT LIBERTY' " TO RUN AT ODETTE'S BEGINNING SEPT. 4

PHILADELPHIA, PA -- The box office window is about to open on a brand-new comedic adventure for Philadelphia region audiences, when Lansdale, PA, native Andy Prescott launches his one-man comedy with music, **ANDY PRESCOTT 'AT LIBERTY'** in the Cabaret Room at Odette's Restaurant in New Hope, PA on Wednesday, September 4. Prescott brings the show to his home state for a month-long run after garnering initial success in New York earlier this year. Slated to run every Wednesday night in September at 8pm (Sept. 4, 11, 18 and 25), tickets may be reserved by contacting Odette's at 215.862.3000. There is a \$15 cover charge and an \$8 minimum.

An autobiographical comedy about a piano bar player struggling to find his niche and achieve his unique dream of stardom in the world of cabaret, **ANDY PRESCOTT 'AT LIBERTY'** is based on the entertainer's own experience as a veteran piano bar performer. A funny and poignant behind-the-scenes adventure, Andy Prescott's one man show takes audiences beyond the ivories, into the life of a lovable optimist who gets the world on a string.

Regulars of Odette's will recognize Prescott as the pianist who for years tickled the ivories and captivated crowds on Friday nights, and the production is inspired by his longing to bring his own show into the "cabaret room across the hall." In **'At Liberty'** he achieves success by enlisting the aid of a jazz band of lesbians -- in real life, he has made his dream come true in front of sold out audiences.

AT LIBERTY was written collaboratively by Prescott sharing credit with Broadway actress/comedienne **Julie Halston** (*The Women, The Man Who Came to Dinner, Sex and the City*); Broadway conductor and arranger **Jeffrey Klitz** (*Chicago*); and Off-Broadway actress and writer **Barbara Suter** (*Finally Flannery*). With big band jazz music scored and recorded by Klitz, the 60-minute comedy with music was originally performed at **Don't Tell Mama (New York City)** in early 2002 and has been revised and expanded for the current production. Prescott says **'AT LIBERTY'** is "one man's journey to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness."
